

CREATION of a NEW RAEL RACING TEAM!!!!



No, you don't have to worry for his safety or his health, RAEL hasn't decided to race again. But he is racing everyday.... virtually.... using a new online simulation called Live For Speed 2. And you may join him and race with him! (well, behind him J)

This simulation is the best in the world and thousands of the people who pilot there are "hard core" passionate. If you like arcade games, this simulation is absolutely not for you. But if you want to really feel what is a real racing car, refine thousands of details in the suspension, adapt them to each circuit, then you will really enjoy it.



And RAEL is giving the example using this simulation to spread the Messages ! Tens of players have already downloaded the Messages after chatting with our Prophet during the game.

If you want to "diffuse" as well using this tool (to spread the Messages while playing is a dream!), here are a few recommendations: add the term "raelian" to your pseudo ("raelien" if you are French).

As an example, you could be " Chris Raelien" or Thomas Raelian".... and then, we recommend that you use psychology.

This simulation gathers people who are fond of car racing and not particularly fond of spirituality. So instead of sending them to www.rael.org , it is better to send them to something related to their main interest : racing cars! On our website there is a page that speaks ONLY about racing cars, the page where are gathered pictures of the prestigious cars that RAEL has been driving during races: www.rael.org/racing/ ! Once on the site, it is likely that the visitors will go and see the other pages about the Messages.... and they could download the Messages for free!

If we send the players to rael.org, they may not be interested by its spiritual content at first and may feel victims of propaganda and become hesitant. But they are all crazy about cars!

Here is what RAEL says about the way he "diffuses" while playing:

" I always introduce myself as a professional pilot and I offer them to see my racing cars on the site, especially the prestigious ones that I drove, like Viper , Lamborghini, Lotus etc... and to tell me by email, if they want, the one they prefer... (there is an email to contact me directly on that page). This creates a friendly link and once they are there, by curiosity, they check the rest of the site and download the book of the "true" pilot with whom they compete (there aren't many true pilot thereJ) on LFS."

All the raelians who play on LFS should adopt this strategy, talking about RAEL and promoting [rael.org/racing](http://www.rael.org/racing) and sending the players on the site with the pictures of RAEL, a racing car pilot, telling them that he is also playing sometimes on LFS and that he is the one who recommends to his followers to play on LFS. You may tell them that there is an email address where they can contact him directly.

One more thing, you can paint your racing car with the colors of the Rael Racing team thanks to Photoshop!

How to play? This is simple. You first need a computer and a wheel with pedals (the Microsoft's one is the best), then you need to download the game (the new one S2) from the site www.liveforspeed.net (you cannot find it in shops, it is only available online). Its cost : 24 English pounds. Then you connect to the site and you will be with players from all over the planet, including RAEL himself...



One more recommendation: you should train yourself, on your own, before competing with others, otherwise you may disturb everybody and be kicked out... (players can vote to kick out and even definitely ban dangerous pilots or those who are disturbing the fast pilots when they are passed)... so make sure you leave room for the fastest when they reach you and you see the blue flag that is shown to you, like in a real race!

He is also the one who answers the emails sent to RAEL by the players... Also, from time to time, he creates a room, reserved to raelians, called WWW.RAEL.ORG (in capital letters so that it is easier to find among hundreds of rooms). You can do the same! And you can click on the question mark in the room list to find out who is in there and meet with other raelians... or RAEL himself if you are lucky! Chris will also have a mailing list to let all the members of the RRT know in advance when he or one of the members creates a private room, giving you the password as well when it is private....

Have fun racing and great "diffusion" ! J


AFRICAN DIASPORA, WELL DONE !!!

50 documents « Africa wake-up » have been handed to:

- 38 presidents of associations.
- 1 to the education minister of Senegal
- 1 to the Ambassador of Senegal in France.
- 1 to an assistant of the mayor of Lyon (of North African origin).
- 4 to various journalists.
- 5 during raelian gatherings

We participated to 20 conferences and debates where we delivered the document as well :

- 1 At a town hall in Lyon where we met the ambassador of Guinea
2. At a ceremony to commemorate the African soldiers who died for France
3. At 2 Christmas meals where we were invited. We met the ambassador of Niger
4. dancing parties organized by associations.
5. I invited the president of the association of Cameroon for a meal at home.
6. New Year's eve with friends from Cameroon
7. Demonstration with people from Ivory Coast in January, in front of the Ivorian consulate.
8. Demonstration in the streets of Lyon with people from Togo in February.

9. On Women day (March 8th), I read our pamphlet about feminization in front of the mayor and the 200 people gathered in the town hall of the 3rd district in Lyon.

GAY PRIDES

Last week end was gay pride week end in many places.... of course we couldn't miss the one of San Francisco, J The regional guide, Felix Clairvoyant tells us :

As Raelians in San Francisco gathered to commemorate the Stonewall uprising of 1969, what is widely believed to be the beginning of the gay rights movement, for the first time, the Raelian Movement entered a contingency in the SF Gay Pride Parade, masterfully orchestrated by Craig Fuller with directives from Fabrice and where more than a million people gathered.



Together, Craig and I carried a beautifully designed banner bearing the word ARAMIS - Raelian Association for Sexual Minorities and we were joined by ten family members from around the Bay area dressed completely in white and wearing beautiful butterfly and angel wings. We distributed 2000 fliers to a very receptive crowd. Hundreds of thousands of people were reported to have lined the parade route, many cheering as we passed and offering thumbs up and nods of approval for our additional posters, "Gay Rights = Human

Rights," "Sexual Orientation = 100% genetic," "California = 1st Gay Country," and "A Message from the Designers." Those of us handing out fliers were pleased at how many reached for a flier, even from back rows, asking for fliers, or even, "Are you Raelian?" and smiling.

Even though our contingency was located near the end of the parade gathering, the crowds remained strong until the final contingency passed. And we were equally pleased to be flanked before and after by members of the Green Party and the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) respectively. The contingency leader for the ACLU graciously asked us if we had powerful Raelian statements so he could chant them using his megaphone. So frequently throughout the march he would say: "Raelians say "gay rights = human rights" followed by: "Raelian priest will marry you." or "Raelians, make some noise." J

From the Parade's opening contingency to the rear of the lineup, the spirit and sentiment could be felt throughout the crowd, gender equality and human rights for all. This was a tremendous experience for all of us, a joy to be able to share the hope of our Creators in a loving and accepting atmosphere. The climate of acceptance continues to change, demonstrating our need to stay focused on the mission entrusted to our Beloved Prophet.

The Thing We Don't Talk About

With the revelation of the secret Downing Street Minutes, which exposed the fact that George Bush and Tony Blair had decided to invade Iraq in April of 2002, a heated debate has blown through media, congressional and activist circles. The decision to go to war in Iraq was made before any public debate was initiated, before the United Nations was brought into the conversation, confirming that Bush's blather about wanting peace and leaving war as the last resort was just that: blather.

So why did we go?

It had been suspected, and has now been confirmed by the Minutes, that Bush took us to war on false pretenses and by way of a whole constellation of lies and exaggerations. First it was the weapons of mass destruction that were not there. Then it was connections between Saddam Hussein and al Qaeda that did not exist. Finally, it became about bringing freedom and democracy to the region, which has emphatically not happened.

Threaded through the discussion was the belief that Bush and his petroleum-company allies lusted after Iraq's oil. There was also the idea that Bush wanted Saddam's head because of the "unfinished business" left by his father in 1991. Some whispered that Iraq had intended to change the monetary basis of its petroleum dealings from the dollar to the Euro, an action that would have spelled financial disaster for the boys in Houston. Finally, many believed Bush ramped up a war push in order to give Republicans a flag-waving platform to run on in the 2002 midterms.

All of these were on the table as reasons for an invasion, though most of them were not included in public debate. Yet the real reasons behind this war, the real reasons for many of our military actions over the years, were never discussed. As with almost everything we deal with today in the foreign policy realm, the real reasons we invaded Iraq harken back to World War II and the Cold War.

When the United States jumped into World War II, President Roosevelt ordered the American economy be put on a wartime footing. This was a sound decision: the country had to speed its industrial capabilities up to a sprint in order to manufacture a huge fighting army out of whole cloth. The action was successful beyond measure. The economy was invigorated, the war was won, and in the process the military/industrial complex, so named by President Eisenhower, was established as a power player in the American economy.

In 1947, President Harry Truman put forth the Truman Doctrine, a broad policy of foreign intervention to combat the feared spread of Communism around the world. The Doctrine was essentially created by a small band of men like Paul Nitze, who were the precursors of what we now call neo-conservatives. Nitze, it should be noted, was the mentor of Paul Wolfowitz, who went on to be the mentor of Donald Rumsfeld and Dick Cheney.

The establishment of the Truman Doctrine, the establishment of the "permanent crisis" that was the Cold War, required that the American economy remain on a wartime footing. There it has remained to this day, despite the fall of the Soviet Union and the collapse of the threat of a global communist takeover. Ten thousand books have been written on this subject, on the impact of our wartime economic footing upon domestic policy, the

environment, global affairs and politics. In the end, however, the fact that our economy is set on a wartime footing means one simple thing.

We need wars.

Without wars, the economy flakes and falls apart. Without wars, the trillions of dollars spent on weapons systems, military preparedness and a planetary army would dry up, dealing a death blow to the economy as currently constituted. Without wars or the threat of wars, the populace is not so easily controlled and manipulated.

Let us be clear, however. When I say "we," I do not refer to your average working man and woman on the street. The man running the shoe store or the woman managing the bar does not need war to remain economically viable. The "we" I speak of is that overwhelmingly wealthy and powerful few who have wired their fortunes into the manufacture of weapons, the plumbing of oil, and the collection of spoils through political largesse.

These are the people who need war. They need it to pile up the contracts from the Pentagon, to enrich the banking institutions that protect them, to pay the lawyers who defend them, to pay the lobbyists who sustain them, to purchase the politicians who champion them, and to buy up the media that hides them from sight.

Yet though this group is small in number, they are "we," for they are our leaders and our myth-makers. They have convinced the majority of this population that war is a necessity. They create the premises for combat and invasion, they convince and cajole and, when necessary, frighten us into line. All too often, almost every time, we buy into the fictions they manufacture, thus sustaining the "permanent crisis" mentality and the need for war after war after war.

The economic need for war creates the required excuses for war. The "permanent crisis" of the Cold War motivated the United States to support the Shah in Iran, a decision that led to the Islamic Revolution and the establishment of Iran as a permanent enemy. The Cold War motivated us to support Saddam Hussein financially and militarily as a bulwark against Iran. The Cold War motivated us to establish the House of Saud in Saudi Arabia to ensure a steady supply of oil. The Cold War motivated us to support Osama bin Laden and the so-called "Jihadists" in Afghanistan in their fight against the Soviet invaders.

Now, we prepare to invade Iran. We have invaded Iraq for the second time in 15 years. We will never invade Saudi Arabia, despite the fact that this nation's vast wealth and Wahabbist extremists make it the birthing bed of international terrorism. We lost two towers in New York City at the hands of a group that we created in the 1980s to fight the Soviets. Put plainly, the "permanent crisis" of the Cold War created a cycle of military self-justification. We build enemies with arms and money, and then we destroy them with arms and money, thus keeping our wartime economy afloat.

The Cold War ended more than ten years ago, but we still need war, and we need that "permanent crisis" to continue the cycle of military self-justification. If a legitimate war is not available, we will create one because we have to. We have our new "permanent

crisis," which we call the War on Terror, another turn of the cycle created by an attack that our foreign policy and war-justifications of the last 50 years made almost inevitable.

We need wars. That's why we are in Iraq. This invasion and occupation of that nation has given our economy the war it needs, and has also created the justification for future wars by creating legions of enemies in the Mideast and around the world. Our wartime economy will tolerate no less.

Talking about Bush's lies regarding weapons of mass destruction, or about bringing democracy to the region, or about the dollar-to-Euro transfer, or about the midterm elections, is window-dressing. We invaded Iraq because we had to. This is the elephant in the room, the foreign policy reality nobody talks about.

If you want peace, work to change the underpinnings of our economy. Until that change is made, there will always be wars, invasions, and lies to bring such things about. It is what it is.
