On the scientific side in Ivory Coast

It is my pleasure to share the beautiful campaign for the development of Biotechnology and GMO organized with the guide Hortense Dodo in Ivory Coast.

During their vacations in Ivory Coast, their country of origin, the beautiful and gracious Professor Hortense Dodo, raelian bishop, Ph.D. in Molecular Biology, teacher and researcher at the University of Alabama, and the charming Dr. Konnan Koffi, also raelian, Ph.D. in genetic engineering, teacher and researcher at the university of Alabama as well, participated in many activities for the promotion of science, GMO, but also sexuality, feminine leadership and femininity.

Here are the remarkable results:

- 2 conferences at the national University of Abidjan with the presence of the President of the University, the director of the Bioscience department, the national press. 150 computers were donated to the University by the US Black diaspora lead by Hortense.
- 1 scientific conference at the National Center for Agronomic research
- 5000 pamphlets and posters distributed on the campus by the young raelian team.
- 5 radio shows (more than 10 million people listening)
- 5 articles published in the most important press media of the country.

A TV show should be aired this Friday, the 26th, as the final of this wonderful tour of Hortense and Koffi in Africa.

Several private meetings took place as well at the highest level of the political



organization here, at the Presidency, the Congress, a few ministers, but also with an association of women farmers who came from far to meet with Hortense. All these people are now more knowledgeable and opened to GMO.

Following this campaign, several projects are being initiated in Ivory Coast: the building of a laboratory on biotechnology at the University of Abidjan, and a promotion campaign of biotechnologies as a government project! Congratulations Hortense, Koffi and the whole organization team, Raelito, Loba, Adadjo, Epokou, Niahi, Gbi,)

This message to share with you the pleasure we had to deliver our books to Professor Kevin Warwick, famous English Cybernetician from Reading University near London.

We were 4, Nathalie, Régnier, Emael and myself, at the "The Nano-bio-cogno-convergence" symposium organized in Leuven for doctors, industrial, scientists and students, all specialized in nano- and bio-technologies.

We arrived during the break there, not knowing who to talk to. We found a secretary who told us we should have taken an appointment but went to find out if we could meet him. So we sat in the entrance waiting for a possible authorization to meet the Professor. While we were seated there, a man arrived and sat next to us, an orange in his mouth.

Nathalie who was carrying the books, was also well organized and had a picture of Kevin Warwick. She identified our neighbor as the Professor and told us. We started to stare at him then, trying to make sure and of course he was quite intrigued to see us staring. This is when the secretary arrived running and told him we wanted to talk to him. Still with his orange in the mouth he looked at us and said "This strange people?" with a mischievous smile. He stood up and shaked our hands asking who we are. Nathalie then explained that we are Raelians who wanted to congratulate him for the work he does for Humanity and that we would love to give him two books. He was very touched and intrigued by the books. When he saw the title "Yes to Human Cloning " he expressed a hmmmm of interest and gave us a large smile. He then offered to let us come in the auditorium for his conference. He said " I will tell them you are friends"... A few seconds later he came back with the secretary and told us we could come in.

We are then given a pass to attend and a seat just when the conference is about to start. His intro was about cybernetics and what it will give to the future, saying that this is not science fiction and that.... media are distorting what he says (eh eh). He talked about his research with lightness and humour. For him, the man of tomorrow will be a cyborg. He talked a little bit about the transfert of information from computers to brains, communication through internet.
