Gravitons, vibration and love

This morning, I watched a video made by one of the top scientists of the Raelian Movement, Michel Devaux, who commented on a new discovery about “quantum science.” You can see this video on YouTube. It’s wonderful. Like I predicted a long time ago, he connected a new particle, unknown for now, that I was calling “graviton,” which is the new discovery of quantum physics. He describes beautifully these smallest particles.

The small particles are very interesting to study. Before, people thought the atom was the smallest particle, and the name “atom,” from the Greek “atomos,” means: something you cannot divide. Primitive people cannot imagine that there is not a minimum size of particle and a maximum size of space. So, regularly, science finds smaller particles, and all scientists, with their huge ego and pride, regularly say: “We found the smallest particle, there is nothing smaller.” In the same way, astronomers say: “The size of the universe is like that,” and top scientists say: “Nothing can go faster than the speed of light.” They just talk about the limit of their knowledge.

Regularly, they say that the universe is bigger: it’s not bigger, we just see more! It’s the same for the atoms; regularly, we develop technologies which make it possible to see something smaller. Bigger and smaller. And we have a beautiful symbol: infinity. Infinitely large and infinitely small. And what is the size of infinity? (laughter) Infinity cannot have size. If you try to explain half of infinity, you have a big mathematical problem. Same for the infinitely small.

And this Raelian scientist explains very well the smallest particles. Some of them, we know, we see their effects. For example, the

photons: you cannot see the photons. Foton, yes; photons, no. But you see me, and we see each other because of the photons; they hit you and me, and you can see the colors or the shapes. But there are smaller particles that scientists already know; when a photon comes, it rebounds on us, and we see. But the smallest particles don't rebound on us; they go through. They go through!

Right now, you have a lot of particles going through you; through you, through the Earth. They are so small, they enter one side of the Earth, and they go through the Earth and out on the other side. And when you study the infinitely small, what quantum physics is discovering is that the smallest particles are not particles, they are vibrations.

And recently, you saw scientists who succeeded in taking a photo of small particles. It's beautiful: they are like the Korean flag. You saw it? It's exactly like the "yin-yang" symbol. You can really see the white and the black turning. It's a fact. It's not a belief; it is. And we can slowly discover that it exists. Scientists before always imagined the atom round, almost like a metallic ball. – Wrong! – It's a vibration! Everything is vibration; you are vibration; we are vibration.

What you see when you look at other people, or at yourselves, is vibration. I was announcing the graviton last year, and the Raelian scientist made a beautiful theory about it. He said: "This vibration, what is it? It's everywhere. The Earth is turning, it's vibration, but it's so big that we don't see it. We are vibrating by the gravitation of the Earth, what makes the Earth not escape from the Sun, it turns around." Normally, when there is energy, hop, it escapes. No. Same for the electrons, same for the galaxies. What is it? "We found a name: gravitation." Gravitons! And what if it's love? Love is the same thing; we cannot see it, but it's here. Love is a vibration. You know it: when you are in love, it vibrates, right? But what is it? Particles: gravitons! Infinity is gravitons, vibrations!

Every scientist tries to see the infinitely small. They want to find a specific shape, and they represent the atom by a kind of ball of many colors. But when you go deep into the infinitely small, there are no balls, you cannot see anything. There are no balls; there is only vibration that we represent by balls. Electrons turning around the center of the atoms. It's not a ball; you can never find a ball – bowl of rice, yes – but in the matter, in the infinitely small and infinitely large of the matter, in fact it's empty.

Our body, and everything in the universe, is full of emptiness, but we see something. That's what is beautiful. If we take the body of someone and compress it, there is a tiny amount of matter and a lot of emptiness. That – and this is what I bring today – that's why meditation is so important. Meditation is not feeling the matter but feeling the emptiness. Emptiness is love! In vibration, there is no matter; you cannot take a photo of vibration, but you can feel it. When you meditate, you can feel the vibration of the universe, and it's love. That's why it's so important to spread love. When we spread love, we put ourselves in harmony with infinity. Like when you have a musician who uses a diapason. You know, if you use a diapason and you make it vibrate, if there is a diapason beside it, it starts to vibrate also. You know that. Why? There is no contact between them, there is vibration! And love is the diapason of the universe: when you vibrate with love, you vibrate in unison. Beautiful name "unison": "uni," like uni-verse; "uni-son," like, similar to "one sound."

When together we do (the sound) AOM, we vibrate in unison. And that's very important, because to be in unison means vibrating together. When we meditate together, our vibrations become ONE: one with ourselves and one with the universe. In other words, the Earth, the universe, the planets, are affected by your vibrations. When you vibrate, the Earth feels it; and when the Earth vibrates, you feel it, especially when there is an earthquake, but it's so small.

You know, the Earth, the part we use, is very small. I'm sure you all have boiled milk; everybody did it. After you boil the milk, a little skin forms at the top; you know that. The thickness of the Earth is similar to the skin on the milk, it's very small, and below there is fire, lava, magma. But the place where we live is tiny; the vibrations are earthquakes. So, we are very, very lucky to be able to feel the vibrations. I'm sorry to disappoint you: I love earthquakes. I love it.

When we experienced the big earthquake in Tako, I remember it, (it was) so good! It's not good if the house falls on you. But the vibration itself is beautiful; you feel that everything is vibration. And we breathe the atmosphere; it's another milk skin. If you go back and you look at the Earth, there is a very tiny atmosphere, and we need to breathe. If you go higher than ten thousand meters, you have almost no oxygen. Oxygen is just close to the skin.

You travel with airplanes; many people believe that oxygen comes from outside, from the window of the airplane. – [wrong!] – Of course, no window is open! Outside the airplane there is no oxygen. So, what you breathe is coming from a big tank which gives you oxygen to survive. That's why when you start to travel in an airplane, the flight attendant says: "In case of depressurization," meaning if there is no more pressure, you have no oxygen, and you remember, if you take airplanes, there is a mask falling that you have to wear, because there is no oxygen. And if you don't put on the mask, you die. Very simple! So, this is a tiny skin on the milk: the atmosphere of this wonderful planet, which is alive.

Some people now are developing a theory saying: "The Earth is alive." It's very difficult for normal scientists to apprehend this idea, but everything is alive. The galaxy is alive, the universe is alive, infinity is alive, and we are part of it. That's why meditation is so important: to feel this oneness. When you vibrate, you affect the universe, and if you meditate, you feel the vibration of the universe, because everything is vibration, not only your vibrator.

Check on YouTube (Rael Francophone), the video of this French Raelian. He is very careful, because if we say everything we feel, people think we are crazy; but if we say everything, they will think we are more crazy. If you talk about UFOs, you are labelled crazy; you know it. If you talk about UFOs, people say: "Take some rest." And for the infinitely small and infinitely large, it is the same thing. I remember the faces of the people, sometimes I talk to a group of scientists, when I say: "There is life in your fingers, planets, galaxies," their face starts to be almost like a psychiatrist, but this is for normal scientists. Very advanced scientists don't laugh; they know it.

One of the people working at the particle accelerator in CERN – you know, it's a big circular tunnel of many kilometers, where, with huge energy, they accelerate the particles and make them collide to see if they can see other particles – and in the Message, and in my teachings, I explain that this is very bad. That fission, meaning cutting, is very bad. Why? Because you have planets, solar systems, and human beings in the infinitely small, and by breaking atoms, you can create cataclysms much bigger than earthquakes. And this scientist who worked at CERN told me: "Maitreya, we talk with other scientists, and we are concerned ourselves, and a part of us supports stopping this experiment, because they start to realize they can affect life in the infinitely small." You are lucky; you have information that advanced scientists are still wondering about.

So, thanks to the Message of the Elohim, we are very lucky. We understand, and we feel what top scientists cannot understand or feel. One more time, be careful: don't try to understand infinity! We will never, ever, be able to understand infinity. And if we try, we can become very crazy. And that's why when the Elohim's Message comes, they say: "Don't try to understand it, feel it! When you feel it, you become one with infinity. If you try to understand it, you separate yourselves from infinity."

So, meditate!

Be good at nothing

This morning, I feel the Elohim more than ever. They are watching everything happening on Earth, full of hope. Raelians and the Elohim – we are the same, yet different from the majority of people. There are yin and yang, good and evil, and human beings always seem to find reasons to forget the Elohim.

At the beginning, people devoted their lives to the Elohim. Moses brought wonderful messages, but the people created a golden calf, making an idol. A real idol is treated as a god, but it is always made of something: wood, stone, or gold. What's more valuable, an idol made of stone or one made of gold? It's the same. They are the same, they are worthless, nothing!

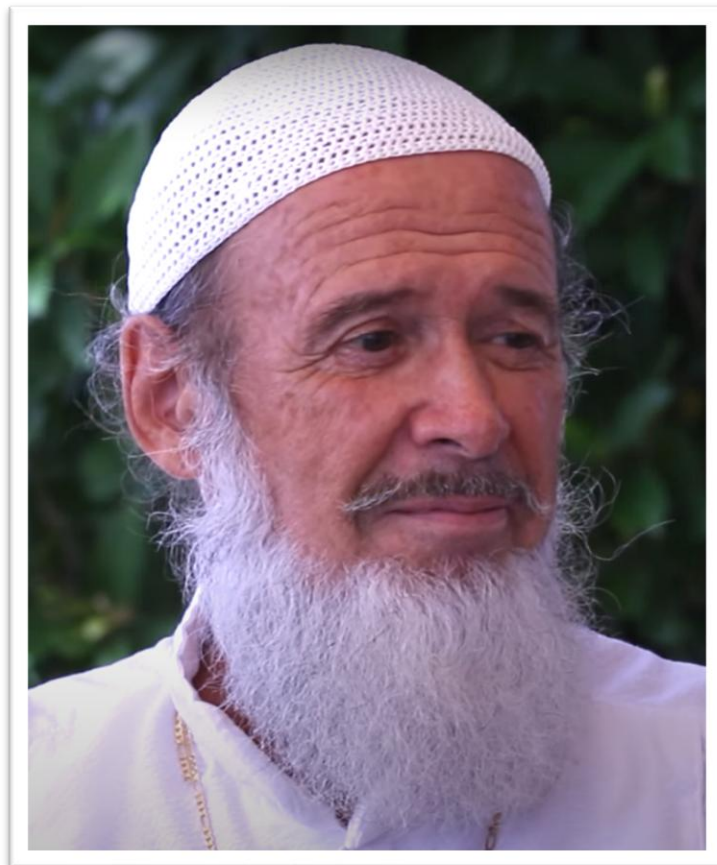
And the message of the Elohim is very clear: do not worship idols made of stone or gold, because you have only one creator – only one, but plural: the Elohim. Why would you take a piece of stone and suddenly pray in front of it? You must give thanks every day for your life – to the Elohim, not to a piece of stone. The stone was not

beautiful, so they made it of gold. They made a golden calf and prayed to it every day.

“Elohim? Who are the Elohim?” they asked, even though the command was very clear: Do not bow before idols! And Moses had to fight hard against them. He smashed the golden calf and cried out: Read the message of the Elohim – no idols! Be thankful only to the Elohim!

Can you imagine? You come to Earth, create life, and hope people will be thankful. Instead, they make a golden calf and bow to it every day. Is it possible to be more stupid? And they believed: “This is God!” – a golden calf, a baby cow made of gold. But it's a beautiful symbol, because it shows that human beings easily turn gold into a god.

Gold! Isn't it still God today? The whole world chases gold; even the words gold and god sound almost the same.



Thousands of years later, Jesus came – my beloved brother. He went to the Temple of Jerusalem, which was built only for loving the Elohim, it was its only purpose. And what did he find? People selling gold. The temple had become a market! There were tables everywhere, and almost no space left to pray to the Elohim. On every table, people were trading gold for a picture of God.

We all know the story. Jesus taught: Love your neighbor, love and love. If someone strikes your left cheek, offer your right cheek. Beautiful teaching. But when he saw gold replacing the Elohim, he became furious. Jesus was angry! He overturned the tables so violently that all the merchants fled in panic, afraid he might strike them.

You must remove the false image of prophets as always calm and non-violent. Yes, they are absolutely non-violent, but when the Elohim are disrespected, action is needed. That's why Jesus drove the merchants out of the temple. That's a very interesting image. Priests don't like to mention that story because it doesn't fit the gentle narrative: non-violent, love your neighbor. But it is true – he destroyed the tables and threw the coins of gold onto the ground!

And what is the supreme power on Earth now? Gold! The world is ruled by banks. Banks created by a Jewish man, Rothschild, who was supposed to love the Elohim. He created the world banking system. Today, no country is ruled by its government; they are ruled by the banks, who hold politicians by the “balls.”

Only two countries expelled Rothschild's banks: Russia – Putin said “Out!” – and China. They declared: “Banks will not rule us. This country belongs to the people. Nobody will make us slaves.” Because in so-called democratic countries, people are slaves without realizing it.

What is a credit card? Nothing but the chain slaves once wore. In the past, slaves had chains to show they belonged to a master. Today, your credit card does the same. You think you own your car or your house? No. They belong to the bank. Stop working, stop paying, and the bank takes everything. Gold rules the world.

Why is there war in Ukraine? Gold. Why was there war in Iraq? Gold. Sometimes a leader tries to change the rules, like Muammar Gaddafi, who wanted to create a people's bank. The bankers didn't want that, so they killed him.

And now, there is a fantastic leader in Africa, in Burkina Faso, doing the same. Of course, he risks his life every day, with so many trying to kill him. Recently, I nominated him as an Honorary Guide of Humanity. He promotes the United States of Africa. I said that fifty years ago. He promotes a single African currency, the Afro. I said that more than thirty years ago. He is putting into practice everything I have been teaching the world for more than 30 years.

France owns more than fifty tons of gold. Where does it come from? There are no gold mines in France. That gold comes from Africa, mainly Burkina Faso. It's so unfair. Once again, like in the time of Moses, like in the time of Jesus, the world bows before a false god: gold.

And Maitreya comes, just in time! Just as Jesus drove the merchants from the temple, I push away everything and everyone standing between humanity and the Elohim. I bring you back to the Elohim. Because all the gold in the world – you will not take even one gram with you when you die. You cannot bring your luxury house, your car, your fortune to the Elohim's planet. Nothing. What you do bring is the love you gave. And that is beautiful.

So today, like every Sunday, we gather to love the Elohim, to remember who they are and who we are. We come from dust and return to dust, but the Elohim offer us eternal life. On their planet, there is no gold. Nothing! And yet everyone is happy. Everyone has a place to sleep. Everyone has food. Nobody works – only being.

That is why I always tell you: Be! If you cannot simply be, then eternal life becomes a punishment. Imagine being depressed forever. The Elohim are not sadists; they offer eternal life only to those who are happy. We are the only religion in the world that makes happiness a duty. Not “you can,” but you must be happy. From the moment you wake up: Wow! Be happy for nothing.

And that brings us to meditation. What is meditation? Nothing. Nothingness. Like when people go to a Zen monastery and ask the master: “Teach me meditation.” The master answers: “Sit down.” One-hour passes. “And now?” – “Sit down.”

When I was a child, teachers and family would tell me: “You’re good for nothing.” They were totally right. I think I am the best in the world at nothing! It sounds easy, but it’s very difficult. Great teachers taught lessons, but I would look outside, watching birds in the trees. My teacher scolded me: “Why don’t you listen?” And I replied: “I learn more from the birds.” He was furious, telling my mother: “He’s good for nothing.” Yes! And I still am. That’s the common thread among prophets: Buddha was good at nothing too. And the only important thing is nothing. When you are good at nothing, then you are ready for eternal life.

When you arrive on the Elohim’s planet – and I know you all deserve it – it’s like going to the Zen monastery. You will arrive and say: “I am alive! What now?” And if an Eloha welcomes you, he will say: “Sit down.” That is eternal life.

Many people work hard their entire lives, and at sixty-five, retire. Suddenly they feel useless and depressed. In America, half of retirees take antidepressants. They have nothing to do, and nothing inside. In that state, nothingness is a punishment. But with spiritual life, nothingness is pleasure.

Practice with animals. You don’t need words with your cat. You look, you feel, and you can spend hours looking at your cat. Then the level of communication with infinity is huge. Animals are teachers. Love them – they show us the way.

I love my cat. He once came to a meeting. He stretches, yawns, sleeps sixteen hours a day. Sixteen hours! People think animals are lazy, but they live beautifully – no banks, no golden idols.

So, practice being good at nothing. Because when you die, if you are lost in activity, you will be lost. But if you are good at nothing, you will continue into eternity.

That is why I call the Happiness Academy a preparation center for eternity. How do you prepare for eternal life? By practicing nothing. When you think nothing, when you do nothing, you are ready. Then any idea of war, domination, and exploitation disappear.

So please – practice.



We witness the action of no-reaction

It's very important, every day, to remember who we are, because it's easy to forget – very easy. There are so many illusions and distractions in life that we can forget. It requires the constant use of supraconsciousness to remember who we are.

This morning, I was watching news on the Internet. And of course, you all know – you all know the desolation, the devastation in Gaza. A journalist took a car and went to the beach in Tel Aviv, just fifty kilometers away. There, everybody was having a party: drinking, dancing, eating – fifty kilometers away from starving people. They were dancing and rejoicing, like celebrating the fact of being Jewish. And the journalist asked: “Doesn't it disturb you that just fifty kilometers away, children have no food?”

That's the question.

Looking with the eyes of the Elohim: fifty kilometers – on one side, devastation, starvation, genocide; on the other side, parties, dancing, food. They forget who they are. If you remember who you are, you fill bags of food and drive them to Gaza. Imagine: you're in Tel Aviv, in a restaurant, and fifty kilometers away a child dies every ten minutes from lack of food. They don't think about it. They dance, they eat, they drink. Amazing!

Me, I cannot watch that without crying. Even remembering this image now, tears come. But no – they dance, they sing, they have parties, they don't care. Of course, we must be happy. Not everyone has to cry for the children of Gaza. Like I said before: we must be happier than normal to fight for peace and love on Earth, everywhere. But fifty kilometers from Gaza! You can walk fifteen hours and you are there. Yet you eat, you dance, you sing, and you don't want to think about the children of Gaza.

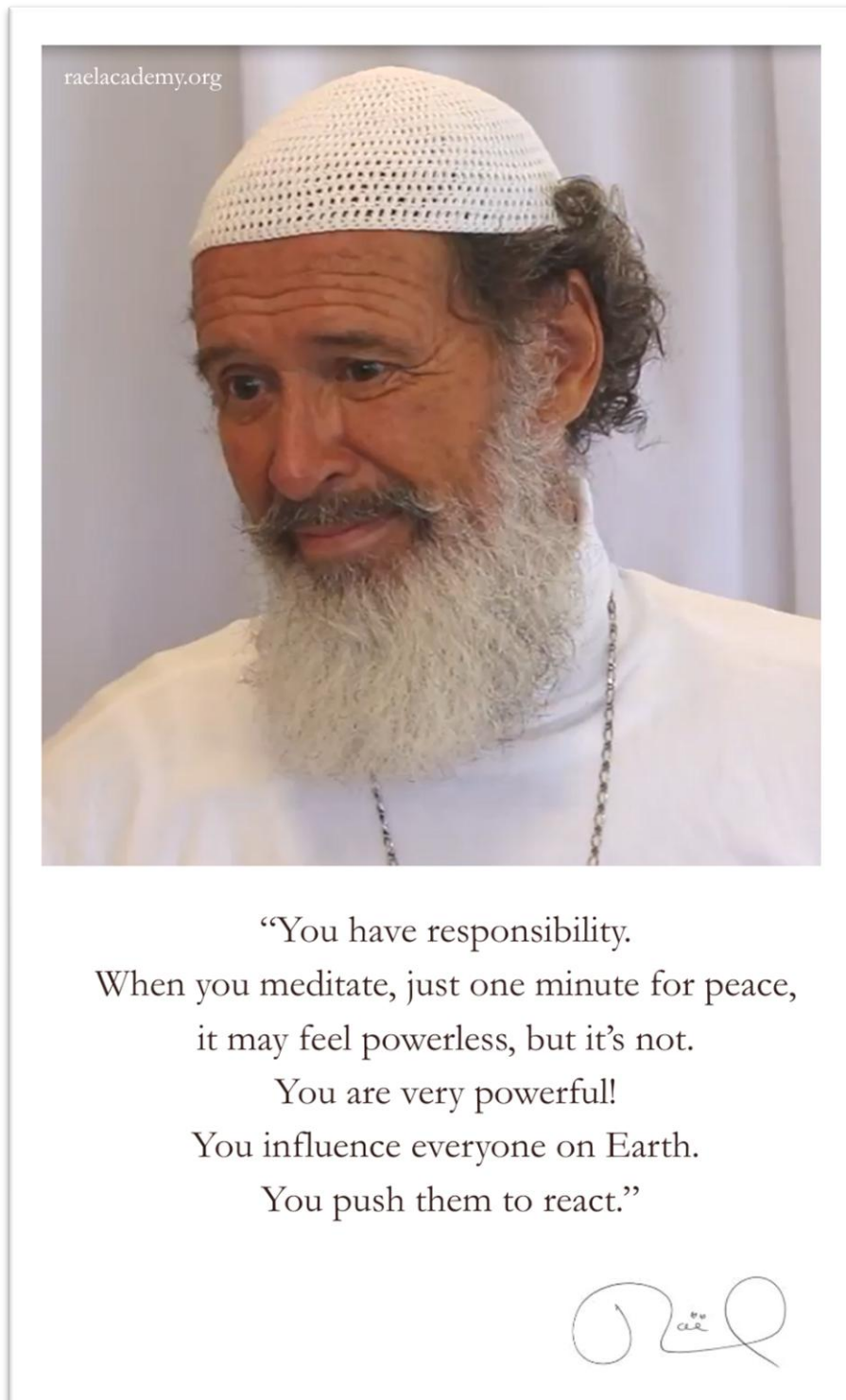
Why are you in Israel? For what reason? To celebrate the Elohim? No. Just to eat, dance, sing. And yet the commandment of the Elohim, their order, is: “Thou shalt not kill.” They don't care. And punishment will come. Israel will disappear, and it will be a bloodbath.

Now the whole world is against Israel: Turkey, all the Arab countries, China, Russia. Almost every country except two is saying: “Israel, if you don't stop, we will come.”

This morning, some people said: “We must destroy the United Nations.” And they are right. What is the purpose of the UN? To avoid exactly this! That was the reason for its existence: to avoid genocides. For many years, in conflicts, the UN sent soldiers with blue helmets to stop the fighting. In Gaza? Nothing. Nobody moves; nobody moves! The UN is like a ghost. It still exists but is completely useless, like a piece of tissue paper – good for the garbage. They have meetings, they vote, and when there was a vote to force Israel to stop the genocide, you would expect everyone to agree. No! England and the United States refused. They know what's happening, but they don't move a finger. This is happening now!

So, expect something very bloody to happen soon. What a time we are living in! Incredible. What happened with the Nazis in Germany is nothing compared to this. After the war, people said: “We didn't know. We didn't know what was happening in Auschwitz, in the camps.” But for Gaza they cannot say that. Everybody knows! That's the big difference. All the TVs of the world show the images. It's genocide live on TV. Every day, children starving, dead children. We see it every day. Painful. Difficult. But the most painful will be after.

Now people say: “It’s terrible.” But they don’t move. Later, in five or ten years, the young generations will ask: “Why did nobody do something?”



Me, I have compassion for the people suffering in Gaza. But I have even more compassion for the future generations – your children, your grandchildren. They will look at humanity and ask: “Why didn’t you do anything?” And nobody can say: “We didn’t know.” That is the most painful thing that will come. If humanity survives – and that is the condition – then it will live with guilt and shame: “Why didn’t you do something to stop it?” And nobody can say: “We didn’t know!” That’s a haunting question; it’s something which will be in the head of humanity forever.

And it is even more painful that this comes from the same people who suffered under the Nazis, who put posters everywhere with the words: “Never again!” Never again? And they are the ones doing it! Even the highest scholars and philosophers inside Israel say: “What we are doing to the Palestinians is worse than what the Nazis did to us.” And they are right. Because this time, it’s live on TV, every day. No one can say: “We didn’t know.” You know. You knew. And future generations will carry this guilt forever. And it’s happening now. Incredible!

Every day I see this, and I am surprised, disappointed by humanity. I look at the computer, I watch the TV, and I say to the Elohim: “Why did you send me into this nightmare? Why?” Even for the last prophet, it is unbelievable. But I am here. And I am the only hope. It is very, very painful for me. I have to trust humanity. The Elohim trust humanity. But with what’s happening, it is very difficult to keep hope because every day we see it, we witness the action of no-reaction.

Israel is a tiny state – seven million people. We are eight billion! We could destroy Israel so quickly. Peacefully! Just take their weapons, say: “No more.” But nothing happens.

So, it is a very difficult time. For the Elohim, for their Prophet. Every day, we cry. And Satan laughs: “I told you! I told you!” Yahweh answers: “No, they will stop it.” And Satan says: “Look, nobody moves!” Exactly like the sacrifice of Abraham.

But we still have hope. Because we trust the Elohim. And if we are still here, it’s because we will do something. Not only us – many movements are starting to rise. Around the world, people are shocked. The governments don’t move, but the people do. The streets are full of protests and they will have to do something. It’s triggering a kind of world revolution. Because no human being can accept this.

And you are part of it. You have responsibility. When you meditate, just one minute for peace, it may feel powerless, but it’s not. You are very powerful! You influence everyone on Earth. You push them to react. The only way to escape this drama is through your meditations for peace. They affect not just people in the streets but also governments. Because what happens in your mind affects the whole of humanity. When you sit in the street and meditate one minute for peace, you change the brain of humanity. Feel it! Don’t sit thinking: “It’s worthless.” It is not. It’s huge! Quantum physics proves it. They call it “entanglement.” When one particle moves here, another moves elsewhere in the universe. The same with your brain. What happens in your brain affects the brain of other people, not only on Earth, but everywhere in the universe.

Let’s return to the teaching of the Elohim. What are we? Not “who,” but “what” are we? Infinity becoming conscious of itself. Each of you – sitting in the street – is infinity taking consciousness of itself. That is huge. Feel this power. That’s why I teach you to say: “I am.” I am what? Infinity becoming conscious of itself. Look at your hand: infinity. Look in the mirror: infinity. Look in each other’s eyes: infinity.

And together, our power grows. When we are together like now, each brain in this room increases the power of the others. That’s the truth, we are very powerful, because we are Raelians. Thanks to the Elohim, they are alive through us. We are the Elohim on Earth. We will build an Embassy to welcome them. But remember, you are the ambassadors, you are their ambassadors – not just me. When you give a pamphlet, when you spread their Message, when you meditate for peace – you are the ambassadors of the Elohim, you are infinity in action.

And after such a dramatic speech, I want to finish with something beautiful – but connected. Recently, a new quantum computer, – which has nothing to do with the computers you know; it’s like comparing a ladybug and an elephant – solved a problem in one minute that would take all the world’s supercomputers forty-seven years.

A quantum computer did it in one minute! That's the gap in technology. Compared to the Elohim, it's still another "ladybug and elephant" situation.

And this week we had another fantastic news. One scientist, who is not in the box like the others, said: "We have to rethink how we imagine UFOs". He said: "It's not possible that they are spacecrafts. The way they move, the



way they react, when some airplanes come close to them, it's impossible". He said: "They appear in one place and instantly appear somewhere else, the same UFO". They appear instantly, disappear instantly. Like I said twenty-five years ago: when I saw the Elohim's UFO in France, there was a flashing light slowing coming. They don't need flashing lights. The flashing lights were only for psychology, to calm us. In reality, if they wanted, they could appear right here, instantly. They don't need a UFO; they can appear here immediately!

Imagine one of the Elohim appearing in the middle of this room – most people would run away in panic. So, everything is psychology. Their technology is completely out of this world. Remember the Elohim's teaching: the belt, the UFO – beautiful! But they also say, "We can move solar systems." The Sun, or another sun, or whole planets – "we will change their place!" It's technology. Like the Bible says: "Science too mysterious for us."

I remember a short video where human beings contacted a primitive tribe in a forest for the first time. The tribe had never seen white people, and when they were shown images on a television, the primitives looked inside and asked,

"Where are these people?" The difference between those primitive people and us – and then us compared to the Elohim – is exactly like that: we are ladybugs. The Elohim's technology is beyond understanding. Don't try to understand it: "Maybe after ten thousand years of progress we will understand." The poor man in the Amazon

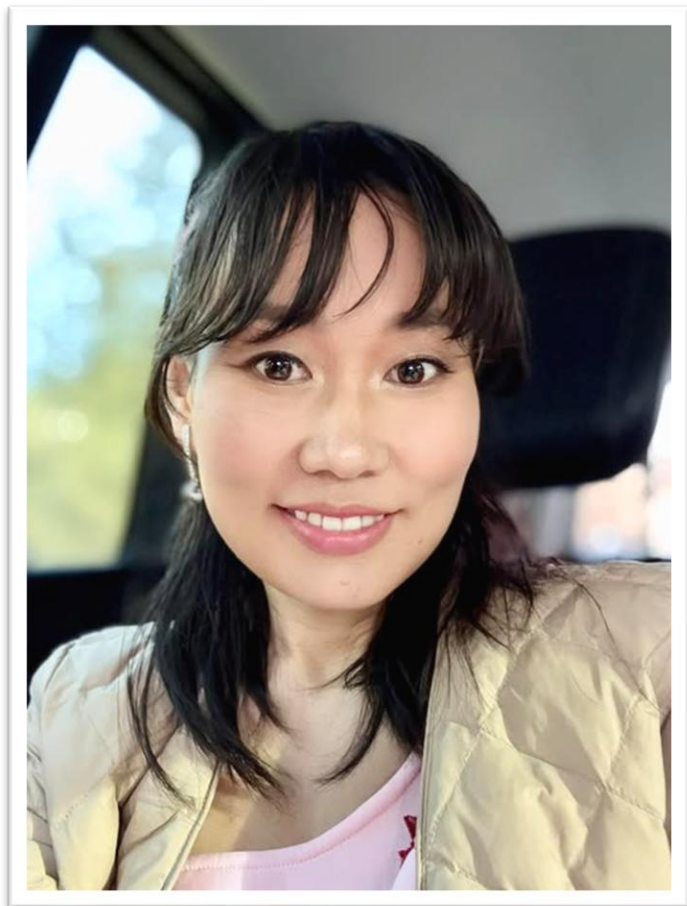
forest cannot understand the television because first he must learn about electricity, where power comes from – so many steps before he sits in his living room watching TV. The difference is like that, but with the Elohim it's not an elephant – it's a million elephants.

It's wonderful, because it helps us keep one very important quality: the capacity to be amazed – amazed by a flower, by an animal, by a ladybug or an ant. Ants have, in a way, a computer in their brain: they always find their nest, they are never lost. Their level of "technology" is astonishing. We are amazed by a drone – it's cute – but one ant has more complexity in its brain than our quantum computers. The same for honey bees. Everywhere around you. So be amazed by everything in the world.

A last little image to keep your sense of wonder: I watch the sunrise every day – do it too! First of all, the Sun does not rise; the Earth turns and we see the Sun coming up. But everybody says, "The Sun rises." Wow! The Elohim, watching people on Earth say "the Sun rises," would roll on the floor laughing. I love the picture of a UFO with a few E.T.s inside laughing like crazy: "Why are they celebrating with fireworks? Because they just did one turn around their sun!" When you celebrate New Year, you celebrate one trip around the Sun. We are so primitive.

To be amazed by this technology is very important for your brain. Aging is not simply the body growing older; aging is losing the capacity to be amazed. I can look at a worm on the road – I love the Japanese name mimizu – and think: it's a supercomputer. You cannot do what an earthworm does; it was made by the Elohim. Never lose that moment of attention to snails, earthworms, ladybugs, mosquitoes, cockroaches – they are amazing. I love cockroaches: open a single egg and you see twelve larvae, like twelve sleeping in a space pods. We don't know how to do that. It's in your house, it's everywhere. Keep this state of mind; if you lose it, you age. "Oh, the sunrise! Oh, a cockroach!"

Be amazed by each other! When I see your faces, I am amazed – each of you. Be amazed by one another. We all have difficulties; we have good days and bad days, but we are alive and we can breathe. Don't take that first conscious breath in the morning for granted. When I wake up – I will be seventy-nine in a few days, still seventy-eight now – before opening my eyes I breathe and say, "Wow – I can breathe." Feel it. Feel the air coming in. Every day, one hundred fifty thousand people die and cannot breathe anymore. But you can stand up, get out of bed, open your eyes. Be amazed by that! If you don't pay attention, you lose your youth. Right now, millions are in hospital – easy to visit – old people with walkers, tubes to breathe. You come here with no tube; you can breathe, you can walk. Enjoy every second.

Letter to U.S. President Donald Trump from Dr. Wenner, Neuroscientist and Raelian Bishop

Dear Mr. Trump,

We all condemn and mourn the assassination of Charlie Kirk and all our sympathies go to his loved ones. As you rightly said, “violence and murder are the tragic consequences of demonizing those with whom you disagree. This kind of rhetoric is directly responsible for the terrorism in our country today and it must stop right now”. Yes, that is very true, and I commend your wise insight, but Mr. Trump, you also have to take some blame here yourself.

Isn't accusing immigrants of “poisoning the blood of our country” at your campaign rally in December 2023 direct demonization? Or “murder, it's in their genes” in your Hewitt radio interview on October 2024?



Or your good friend Netanyahu who accused all Palestinians of being “predators and wild beasts” on his tour of the Jordanian border in February 2016. Or his deputy defense minister Eli en-Dahan who stated “Palestinians are like animals, not human”, as did Nissim Vaturi, Likud deputy speaker, publicly calling them “scum and subhuman”.

Not only are these public figures, whom it appears you visibly support, demonizing Palestinians, which gives them permission to starve and massacre innocent women and children, but you and they also act as world role models, teaching that it is OK to kill anyone with whom you disagree, even without a fair trial. If it is OK to air-strike Qassem Soleimani, or assassinate a Palestinian child just because they are labelled “subhuman” or if they just happen to be in the way, then it suggests it is OK to shoot an American politician, or, why not, your neighbor with a different point of view. Yes, permission to kill with impunity: that is the message that you yourself are propagating when you bomb a sovereign state, or publicly support another country for doing so, or support them executing without trial, or turn a blind eye to child massacre, and I invite you to take responsibility for it.

What you do in one part of the world has repercussions in the rest. We are all swimming in the same pool, if you pee on one side, sooner or later you will bathe in it on the other. As you so rightly say: “it must stop right now”.
